RE: WORLDWIDE EXPRESS (UK) LTD - CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE & STORAGE

Following a recent review meeting with our Insurance brokers, we have been asked to re-affirm the basis on which we carry and / or store goods on behalf of our clients.

We would therefore advise that, in common with the majority of professional carriers, all goods transported within the United Kingdom are carried under the terms & conditions of the Road Haulage Association (R.H.A) Conditions of Carriage - 1998 edition - but with the standard limit increased to £13,000.00 per tonne.

All goods subject to a contract for storage are stored under the terms of the Road Haulage Association (R.H.A.) Conditions of Storage 1998 edition with the standard limit of £100 per tonne applying.

Copies of the above are available upon request.

All goods accepted for shipment to Europe are carried subject to the terms of the relevant International statute or convention - this in most cases being CMR or Warsaw Convention.

All other International movements are subject to the terms and conditions of the British International Freight Association (BIFA) which restrict our liability to a figure of 2 Special Drawing Rights per kilo which currently equates to a figure of circa £1.80 per kilo.

All potential claims are subject to a £250.00 excess.

We do offer and 'ALL RISKS MARINE POLICY', for high value goods which offers very good value and peace of mind. Price on application.
